Duties of NHJFB Members

- Your term will run for one year, but you may re-apply each year.
- You must attend meetings when they are called unless excused beforehand. The NHJFB
 Advisors will determine excused absences or exceptions. Meetings will be held monthly
 from March through October.
- You will be required to assist in planning and take part in many areas of the fair.
- You will be required to work <u>eight hours</u> during fair week in areas that require your assistance.
- You must promote the fair and carry a professional attitude in and around fair activities.
- Use appropriate dress, behavior, and language especially when representing the fair.
- You may be removed at any time during the year for inappropriate, unacceptable behavior or for not fulfilling your duties.
- If you are not serious about this role, please do not apply.
